WHAT? **CREATING TOGETHER**

Learning about, developing and building green technologies (e.g. small wind turbine, solar collector, biogas digester) using limited resources together with an intercultural team.



WHO? **24 PARTICIPANTS**

In total, 24 participants from Slovakia, Belgium, Slovenia, and Ukraine between 18-30 years old can join. No prior experience required! All kind of skills are precious for the team!



WHEN? 17-24TH AUG 2023

Participants will arrive one day EARLIER on the **16.8**. to ensure a smooth arrival. The program starts on the next day morning. Departures of all participants are scheduled for the **25.8.**

The Low-Tech Camp 2023 will take place at the beautiful animal farm and campsite "Modra Farma" which is located in the eco-village Zajezova in central Slovakia.



HOW TO GET THERE? GREEN TRAVEL

Since sustainable practices are central to the camp, all participants can only travel green for the Low-Tech Camp, meaning using the **bus**, train or carpooling.



Travel costs to and from Modra Farma will be reimbursed by LAZY lab (hosting organisation). Accommodation, food and material costs will be **covered** throughout the program.









LAZY lab [Slovakia]

LAZY lab is the applicant and hosting organisation behind the Low-Tech Camp 2023. 



SPACE FOR EXPERIMENTATION



Learn about environmental issues connected to high-tech products and our consumer-driven society and explore "lowtech" as a movement to counter those issues.















- Location: "Modra Farma" (Address: Zajezova 66, 96263 Pliesovce, Slovakia)
- Green travel: Only low-emission travel can be reimbursed (i.e. bus, train, carpooling). If you have questions or issues with your travel arrangements, don't hesitate to contact your assigned group leader or the partner organisation of your country.
- Sleeping: All participants are encouraged to bring their own tent, sleeping bag, and mat. (For participants who have difficulties arranging those that's not a reason not to apply - alternatives can be arranged.) In case of heavy rain, a large seminar room can be used for sleeping.
- Food: Freshly prepared breakfast, lunch and dinner will be provided. All the meals will be vegetarian. Any other dietary requirements from participants will be considered.
- Hygiene: A sufficient number of separate showers and toilets are available.
- Tools & co: All tools, safety protection and work stations will be provided.
