Cilji:

Cilj predmeta je študente seznaniti s problematiko razvoja turizma in rekreacije v Sloveniji, EU in po svetu, predvsem z vidika vseh treh stebrov trajnostnega razvoja. Pri tem je poudarek na sonaravnih aktivnostih turizma in rekreacije, torej takih, ki imajo čim manjše negativne okoljske učinke, a so dolgoročno trajnostni tako z ekonomskega kot tudi socialnega vidika. Specifična kompetenca predmeta je študente seznaniti in usposobiti za uporabo različnih metod kabinetnega in terenskega preučevanja in načrtovanja sonaravnih oblik turizma in rekreacije.

Objectives:

The subject goal is to acquaint the students with the broad issue of tourism and recreation development in Slovenia, EU and on the global level especially from the sustainable development perspective. The emphasis is on the environmentally sustainable activities of tourism and recreation, those that have minimum negative environmental impacts but are economically and socially sustainable in the long run. The specific competence of the subject is to acquaint and to qualify the students to use various research and planning methods (cabinet and field) within the sustainable tourism and recreation.

Predvideni študijski rezultati:

Znanje in razumevanje:

Študent bo ob zaključku tega predmeta sposoben razumeti bistvo sonaravnega razvoja turizma in rekreacije in bo s svojim znanjem lahko pomembno prispeval pri pospeševanju razvoja tistih turističnih in rekreacijskih aktivnosti, ki imajo minimalne negativne okoljske učinke in so hkrati zanimive tudi z ekonomskega in socialnega vidika.

Prenesljive/ključne spretnosti in drugi atributi:

Študenti znajo poiskati in uporabiti relevantno literaturo in vire podatkov ter so seznanjeni s pomembnejšimi načini lastnega zbiranja podatkov (intervjuji, anketiranje, kartiranje ipd.). Razvijajo zmožnosti učinkovitega pisnega in ustnega komuniciranja ter uporabe informacijsko-komunikacijske tehnologije in informacijskih sistemov. Poznajo nekatere pomembnejše načine analize podatkov ter znajo predstaviti dobljene rezultate.

Intended learning outcomes:

Knowledge and Understanding:

The student is able to understand the importance of the sustainable development of tourism and recreation. With the gained knowledge he/she will be able to importantly contribute to the promotion and development of those tourism and recreation activities that are recognized to have minimum negative environmental impacts but are also interesting from the economic and social perspective.

Transferable/Key Skills and other attributes:

The students are able to search and use the relevant references and data sources. They are acquainted by most common manners of individual data collection (interviews, questionnaires, mapping etc.). They develop abilities of effective oral and written communication as well as of the use of ICT and information systems. They are skilled in most important data analysis as well as their interpretation; they also are able to present the results of their work.
